**GLOBAL YOUTH MINISTRY
OUTDOOR ACTIVITIES PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT
ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND RELEASE**

In consideration of the services of Global Youth Ministry, and Alpine Towers International, Inc, their agents, owners, officers, volunteers, participants, employees, and all other persons or entities acting in any capacity on their behalf (hereinafter collectively referred to as GYM/ATI), I hereby agree to release, indemnify, and discharge GYM/ATI, on behalf of myself, my children, my parents, my heirs, assigns, personal representative and estate as follows:

1. I acknowledge that my participation in ropes course, blob, hiking, paintball, and other outdoor activities entails known and unanticipated risks, which could result in physical or emotional injury, paralysis, death, or damage to myself, to property, or to third parties. I understand that such risks simply cannot be eliminated without jeopardizing the essential qualities of the activity.

GYM/ATI programs are based on the "challenge by choice" principle. At any time you and/or your group are free to withdraw from participation in any outdoor activities. The risks include, among other things, the potential for: slips, falls and falling, rope burns, pinches, scrapes, twists and jolts that could result in scratches, bruises, sprains, lacerations, fractures, concussions, or even more severe life threatening hazards. During and activity there may be contact with plants, animals, or insects that could create hazards such as stings, allergies, and associated diseases.

Furthermore, GYM/ATI instructors have difficult jobs to perform. They seek safety, but they are not infallible. They might be unaware of a participant's fitness or abilities, they might misjudge the weather.

2. I expressly agree and promise to accept and assume all of the risks existing in this activity. My participation in this activity is purely voluntary, and I elect to participate in spite of the risks.

3. I hereby voluntarily release, forever discharge, and agree to indemnify and hold harmless GYM/ATI from any and all claims, demands, or causes of action, which are in any way connected with my participation in this activity or my use of GYM/ATI equipment or facilities, including any such claims which allege negligent acts or omissions of GYM/ATI.

4. Should GYM/ATI or anyone acting on their behalf, be required to incur attorney's fees and costs to enforce this agreement, I agree to indemnify and hold them harmless for all such fees and costs.

5. I certify that I have adequate insurance to cover any injury or damage I may cause or suffer while participating, or else I agree to bear the costs of such injury or damage myself. I further certify that I am willing to assume the risk of any medical or physical condition I may have.

6. In the event that I file a lawsuit against GYM/ATI, I agree to do so solely in the state of Georgia, and I further agree that the substantive law of that state shall apply in that action without regard to the conflict of law rules of that state. I agree that if any portion of this agreement is found to be void or unenforceable, the remaining portions shall remain in full force and effect.

By signing this document, I acknowledge that if anyone is hurt or property is damaged during my participation in this activity, I may be found by a court of law to have waived my right to maintain a lawsuit against GYM/ATI on the basis of any claim from which I have released them herein.

I have had sufficient opportunity to read this entire document. I have read and understood it, and I agree to be bound by its terms.

EQUINE PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT
ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND RELEASE**

Global Youth Ministry and Cedar Crest Mountain Stables require that all participants in Equine activities sign this Participation, Assumption of Risk and Release form in order to be eligible to participate in equine activities.

The undersigned acknowledges and understands the following:

1. During Equine activities certain risks and dangers are present, and
2. These risks may include physical or psychological damage and/or injury, not excluding fatality, due to accidents which may occur resulting from Equine activities.

The undersigned agrees that while participating, the participant will abide by all of the policies and procedures of Global Youth Ministry and Cedar Crest Mountain Stables regarding Equine activities provided the participant in order to maintain the utmost level of safety for the participant.

WARNING: UNDER GEORGIA LAW AND EQUINE ACTIVITY SPONSOR OR EQUINE PROFESSIONAL IS NOT LIABLE FOR AN INJURY OR THE DEATH OF A PARTICIPANT IN EQUINE ACTIVITIES RESULTING FROM THE INHERENT RISKS OF EQUINE ACTIVITIES. PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 12 OF TITLE 4 OF THE OFFICIAL CODE OF GEORGIA ANNOTATED.

An Equine animal is defined as a horse or pony. An Equine activity is defined as riding, handling, training, driving, assisting in the medical treatment of, being a passenger on, or assisting a participant or sponsor with an Equine animal.

In consideration of the above, I have and do hereby assume all of the risks of participation in Equine activities and will hold Global Youth Ministry and Cedar Crest Mountain Stables, their employees, agents, trustees, officers, and affiliates harmless from any and all liability, actions, causes of actions, claims, and demands of every kind and nature whatsoever, whether for bodily injury, property damage or loss or otherwise, which my child now has or which may arise from or in connection with my participation in Global Youth Ministry's and Cedar Crest Mountain Stables' Equine program and activities. I, along with my family or heirs, understand and agree that we cannot sue Global Youth Ministry, Cedar Crest Mountain Stables, their employees, trustees, affiliates and associates, and if I do, I cannot collect any money. In addition, I will pay for Global Youth Ministry's and Cedar Crest Mountain Stables' attorney and court fees associated with any litigation I might bring against their employees, agents, trustees, officers, affiliates, and associates. I also state that neither I am nor my child (if I am signing on behalf of my child) is under or will be under the influence of any chemical substance including alcohol, either at the time of the signing of this Agreement or at the time of participating in Equine activities. I fully understand that my child's physical activity involves the potential risk of injury. I also understand that my child's participation in Global Youth Ministry's and Cedar Crest Mountain Stables' Equine program and activities is entirely voluntary.

B. **AGREEMENT SCOPE AND TERRITORY AND DEFINITIONS** This agreement shall be legally binding upon me the registered participant, and the parents or legal guardians thereof if a minor, my heirs, estate, assigns, including all minor children, and personal representatives; and it shall be interpreted according to the laws of the state and county of THIS STABLE'S physical location. This agreement is intended to be valid and binding at all times now and in the future when THIS STABLE permits me (directly or indirectly) to enter THIS STABLE'S property, be on THIS STABLE'S property, be near any horse, receive instruction or guidance from its associates and / or when I ride and / or am near horses on or off of THIS STABLE'S property. Any disputes by the participant shall be litigated in, and venue shall be the county in which THIS STABLE is physically located. This agreement is intended to be as broad and inclusive as the law permits. If any clause, phrase, or word is in conflict with state law, then that single part is null and void. The terms "HORSE" and "EQUINE" herein shall refer to all equine species. The terms "I", "WE", "ME", "MY" shall herein refer to the above registered participant and the parents or legal guardians thereof if a minor.

C. **INHERENT RISKS / ASSUMPTION OF RISKS** I ACKNOWLEDGE THAT: Horseback riding is classified as RUGGED ADVENTURE RECREATIONAL SPORT ACTIVITY and that risks, conditions, and dangers are inherent in (meaning an integral part of) horse / equine / animal activities, regardless of all feasible safety measures which can be taken, and I agree to assume them. The inherent risks include, but are not limited to any of the following: The propensity of an animal to behave in ways that may result in injury, harm, death, or loss to persons on or around the animal; The unpredictability of an equine's reaction to sounds, sudden movement, unfamiliar objects, persons, or other animals; Hazards, including, but not limited to, surface or subsurface conditions; A collision, encounter and / or confrontation with another equine, another animal, a person, or an object; The potential of an equine activity participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury, harm, death, or loss to the participant or to other persons, including but not limited to, failing to maintain control over an equine and / or failing to act within the ability of the participant. Horses are 5 to 15 times larger, 20 to 40 times more powerful, and 3 to 4 times faster than a human. If a rider falls from horse to ground it will generally be at a distance of from 3 1/2 to 5 1/2 feet, and the impact may result in harm to the rider. Horseback riding is an activity in which one much smaller, weaker predator animal (the human) tries to impose its will on, and become one unit of movement with, another much larger, stronger prey animal that has a mind of its own (the horse) and each has a limited understanding of the other. If a horse is frightened or provoked it may divert from its training and act according to its natural survival instincts which may include, but are not limited to: Stopping short; Spinning around; Changing directions and / or speed at will; Shifting its weight; Bucking; Rearing; Kicking; Biting; and / or Running from danger. I also acknowledge that these are just some of the risks and I agree to assume others not mentioned above. I am not relying on THIS STABLE to list all possible risks for me.

D. **WILDERNESS EXPERIENCE PARTICIPATION, CONDITIONS OF NATURE WARNING, UNFAMILIAR AND SUDDEN SIGHTS, SOUNDS AND MOVEMENTS WARNING, AND INSPECTION OF PREMISES** I / WE ACKNOWLEDGE THAT: The participant may be taking part in a "WILDERNESS EXPERIENCE" that may be hazardous to people. I / WE ACKNOWLEDGE THAT The meaning of "WILDERNESS EXPERIENCE" is defined as the pursuit of activity in a natural and / or wild and / or rugged and / or uncultivated area or region, as of forest and / or hills and / or mountains and / or plains and / or wetlands, which would likely be uninhabited by people and inhabited by wild animals of many types and species to include, but not limited to, mammals, reptiles, and insects, which are not tame, may be savage and unpredictable in nature and also wandering at their will. I / WE ACKNOWLEDGE THAT: THIS STABLE is NOT responsible for total or partial acts, occurrences, or elements of nature and / or sudden and / or unfamiliar sights, sounds and / or sudden movements that can scare a horse, cause it to fall, or react in some other unsafe way. **SOME EXAMPLES ARE:** Thunder, lightning, rain, wind, wild and domestic animals, insects, reptiles, which may walk, run, or fly near, or bite or sting a horse or person; and irregular footing on out-of-door groomed or wild land which is subject to constant change in condition according to weather, temperature, and natural and man-made changes in landscape. I also acknowledge that these are just some of the risks and I agree to assume others not mentioned above. I am not relying on THIS STABLE to list all possible conditions for me. The participant and parent or legal guardian have inspected THIS STABLE'S facilities and are satisfied that all premise conditions are reasonably safe for this participant's intended purpose, usage and presence upon THIS STABLE'S premises.

E. **CARRY-ON OBJECTS WARNING AND SHARP, LOUD NOISES WARNING** I / WE ACKNOWLEDGE THAT: When approaching, mounting and riding horses, I must not carry loose items that may fall or blow away or flap in the wind or bounce or make sharp or loud noises, the action of which may scare horses causing them to react in unsafe ways. **SOME EXAMPLES ARE:** Cameras, cell phones, hats not securely fastened under chin, toys, purses. When near or riding a horse, participants must not make sharp or loud noises, such as whistling or screaming or yelling, the sound of which may scare horses causing them to react in unsafe ways.

F. **SADDLE GIRTH LOOSENING WARNING** I / WE ACKNOWLEDGE THAT: Saddle girths (fastener straps around the horse's belly) may loosen during riding. Riders must alert the nearest attendant of any girth looseness so action can be taken to avoid saddle slippage and the potential for the rider to fall from the horse.

G. **PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR / HELMET WARNING AND OFFERING:** I / WE AGREE THAT: I for myself and on behalf of my child and / or legal ward have been fully warned and advised by THIS STABLE that protective headgear / helmet, which meets or exceeds the quality standards of the SEI CERTIFIED ASTM STANDARD F 1163 Equestrian Helmet, should be worn while riding, handling, and / or being near horses, and I understand that the wearing of such headgear / helmet at these times may reduce severity of some of the wearer's head injuries and possibly prevent the wearer's death from happening as the result of a fall and other occurrences. I / WE ACKNOWLEDGE THAT: THIS STABLE has offered me, and my child and / or legal ward if applicable, protective headgear / helmet that meets or exceeds the quality standards of the SEI CERTIFIED ASTM STANDARD F 1163 Equestrian Helmet. I / WE ACKNOWLEDGE THAT: Once provided, if I choose to wear the protective headgear / helmet offered that I / WE will be responsible for properly securing the headgear / helmet on the participant's head at all times. I am not relying on THIS STABLE and / or its associates to check any headgear / helmet or headgear / helmet strap that I may wear, or to monitor my compliance with this suggestion at any time now or in the future.

H. **THIS STABLE'S PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR / HELMET POLICY.** I understand and agree that This Stable requires riders to wear ASTM Standard F 1163 Protective Headgear / Helmet according to the following requirements.

Rider Age	Protective Headgear / Helmet Requirement
5 Yrs and Younger	For their Safety, children 5 yrs old and younger <u>may not</u> participate as a rider in horse rental and trail riding equestrian services.
6 Yrs through 17 Yrs	Must wear the protective headgear / helmet.
18 Yrs and Older	Must choose to wear or not to wear the protective headgear / helmet by checking the acceptance or refusal box that follows.

I. PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR / HELMET ACCEPTANCE OR REFUSAL SELECTION FOR RIDERS 16 YEARS AND OLDER

CAMP RULES

1. Counselor: Your counselor is responsible for you and must always know where you are. Respect and obey your counselor
2. Camp schedule: Be present and on time for everything.
3. Camp boundaries: Never leave the camp grounds. Your room is not a social gathering place. No girls ever in guys room, no guys ever in girls rooms.
4. Camp Care: We expect all campers to respect the camp grounds. Take care of the camp! No loud noise, pillow fighting, or rough housing allowed.
5. Companions: No POPDA. You are not here for that, cool it! Also, No Cell Phones.
6. Clothing : Be comfortable but conservative. Long pants at evening time, capris are fine for girls, jeans for guys. No revealing clothing or vulgar t-shirts. Pool, guys wear t-shirt to and from pool. Girls wear tankini or one piece. If you have two piece, a t-shirt must be worn at all times even in water.
7. Contraband: No drugs, tobacco, alcohol in any form. No cell phones, no ipods, mp3 players. No off camp food to be delivered to rooms.
8. When you go on trails, always go in twos. We have black bears, rattlesnakes, and other critters. You do not ever want to be by your self facing any of these.
