#### INTRODUCTION:

**Once shattered... now whole**

**Once broken... now beautiful**

**Once dirty... now worthy**

**Once dead... now living**

**Once red... now white**

**Once dirty... now clean**

We who have come to faith in Christ recognize these contrasts as descriptive of our lives before we knew Him and after we trusted Him.

But these contrasts are descriptive of something else as well.

They are descriptive of the purposes that some have for you and for me as well.

There are those who want you shattered, broken, dirty, stained, and dead.

And then there are those who want you whole, beautiful, worthy, clean, white, and alive.

Who are these with audacious goals for each of us?

Jesus tells us in John chapter 10.

**John 10:1, 10** “Most assuredly, I say to you, he who does not enter the sheepfold by the door, but climbs up some other way, the same is a thief and a robber. ... **10** The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have *it* more abundantly.

In John 10 Jesus is talking about the sheepfold. The sheepfold is where the sheep are gathered, especially at night. While Jesus is using the illustration of what happens to real, live, wooly sheep, He does so to talk about what happens to His sheep, the talking, two

legged, kind that come in a beautiful variety of colors: red and yellow, black and white. Each is precious in His sight. Jesus is talking about us.

And Jesus says that there are two groups, two sides, so to speak, who are trying to get into the sheepfold and to get to the sheep. And each side has a very definite purpose. And those purposes are as different as night and day.

## I. THE TWO SIDES

**The thieves have a Chief Thief**, just like the priests have a High Priest. Jesus identifies this chief thief in

**John 8:44** You are of *your* father the devil, and the desires of your father you want to do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaks a lie, he speaks from his own *resources*, for he is a liar and the father of it.

**The Chief Thief is the devil, Satan himself.**

**Murderer**

**Liar**

**No truth in him**

The devil is joined by his followers. That is what Jesus was saying to the Pharisees, who refused to believe that Jesus was the Christ. "You follow the devil and you do what the devil wants you to do."

**The Chief Thief is the devil**

**Followed by other thieves, people who refuse to trust in Christ.**

**Assisted by the demons, fallen angels who rebelled against God**

Neither is Jesus alone

**The Chief Life-Giver is Jesus, but**

**Jesus has followers, who by faith in Him have become children of God, and thus are brothers and sisters of Jesus Himself!**

**Assisted by holy angels, who do God’s bidding and minister to God’s children.**

So, here is the picture of the two sides of the conflict and the different purposes they hold.

**Each of these two sides is at war around our lives,**

**ying for control or influence in each area of our lives**

**constantly!**

Ephesians 6:12 For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual *hosts* of wickedness in the heavenly *places*.

2 Kings 6:15–17 And when the servant of the man of God arose early and went out, there was an army, surrounding the city with horses and chariots. And his servant said to him, “**Alas, my master! What shall we do?**”

**16** So he answered, “**Do not fear, for those who are with us are more than those who are with them.**” **17** And Elisha prayed, and said, “**LORD, I pray, open his eyes that he may see.**” Then the LORD opened the eyes of the young man, and he saw. And behold, **the mountain was full of horses and chariots of fire all around Elisha.**

If we could see the fullness of the devil’s army trying to kill us, trying to steal what God has entrusted to our care, trying to destroy our lives, our testimony, our ministries, quite honestly it would scare the strongest of us to death!

But if we could see the fullness of the army of God, led by Christ Himself, the multitude of stalwart angels armed for war, and the host of witnesses who fight for us, we would be fortified, strengthened and comforted.

But, at least for now, we cannot see. That is why God tells us in His Word that although we cannot see it is very real. The chariots of fire were present long before the servant ever saw them!
