

DISCERNING DANIEL

Revealer of Secrets

Text: Daniel 2:31-49

Introduction: God had sent King Nebuchadnezzar a dream, a dream so disturbing that it robbed the king of sleep. He was confident the dream had meaning, but he would not _____ the dream to anyone. He demanded that his royal cabinet of wise men tell him what he dreamed. Then he would trust them to tell him what the dream meant.

The king gave his _____ and _____ a little while to tell him the dream, and if not, they and their families would die; and the king was not playing a game. Royal murder had already been committed when Daniel went to the chief executioner and said, "Take me to the king. I know the answer." So Daniel was brought before King Nebuchadnezzar and...

Dan. 2:26-28 26 The king answered and said to Daniel, whose name was Belteshazzar, "Are you able to make known to me the dream which I have seen, and its interpretation?" 27 Daniel answered in the presence of the king, and said, "The secret which the king has demanded, the wise *men*, the astrologers, the magicians, and the soothsayers cannot declare to the king. 28 **But there is a God in heaven who reveals secrets**, and He has made known to King Nebuchadnezzar what will be in the latter days.

I. GOD REVEALED THE SECRET DREAM.

Dan. 2:31-35 31 "You, O king, were watching; and behold, a great image! This great image, whose splendor was excellent, stood before you; and its form was awesome. 32 This image's head was of fine gold, its chest and arms of silver, its belly and thighs of bronze, 33 its legs of iron, its feet partly of iron and partly of clay.



34 You watched while a stone was cut out without hands, which struck the image on its feet of iron and clay, and broke them in pieces. 35 Then the iron, the clay, the bronze, the silver, and the gold were crushed together, and became like chaff from the summer threshing floors; the wind carried them away so that no trace of them was found. And the stone that struck the image became a great mountain and filled the whole earth.

36 “This *is* the dream. Now we will tell the interpretation of it before the king. **37** You, O king, *are* a king of kings. For the God of heaven has given you a kingdom, power, strength, and glory; **38** and wherever the children of men dwell, or the beasts of the field and the birds of the heaven, He has given *them* into your hand, and has made you ruler over them all

—*you are this head of gold.*

III. GOD REVEALED THE FUTURE.

41 Whereas you saw the feet and toes, partly of potter’s clay and partly of iron, the kingdom shall be divided; yet the strength of the iron shall be in it, just as you saw the iron mixed with ceramic clay. 42 And as the toes of the feet were partly of iron and partly of clay, so the kingdom shall be partly strong and partly fragile. 43 As you saw iron mixed with ceramic clay, they will mingle with the seed of men; but they will not adhere to one another, just as iron does not mix with clay.
