### **BIBLE VERSE**

You will be a witness for him to all people. Acts 22:15 CSB

### **Dig for Buried Letters**

Tools: Bible, play sand, or dry beans or rice or packing peanuts, box or bowl, magnetic letters or small papers with letters on them, word cards: desert, Jesus, Philip, Bible

- Make word cards with one word on each card: desert, Jesus, Philip, Bible
- Use magnetic letters or make small letter cards for letters in the word cards.
- Hide letters in play sand or dry beans or rice or packing peanuts contained in a box or plastic bowl.
- Show a word card and have your child dig for buried letters. Help your child “spell” the word on the word card. Repeat with other word cards.
- Relate the words to the Bible story. Philip knew Jesus and saw the things Jesus did. Philip told the official about Jesus. Philip was a witness.
- Read Acts 22:15 together.

### **Step Out the Bible Verse**

Tools: Bible, activity page, paper, markers, tape

- Print each word of the Bible verse and scripture reference on separate sheets of paper. Number the papers in the correct word order, then tape the papers randomly to the floor. Make sure there is space between the papers so children can step between consecutive words.
- Guide your child to say the Bible verse and step on the corresponding paper by helping them follow the number sequence.
- After your child has stepped out the verse a few times, help them locate the verse in the Bible.
