

Beginning Again!

Although we have been on campus with KZL since June 28, we are now expanding Sunday Morning in the Kid Zone to include classes at 9:00. Whether you have been coming or whether this will be your first time back, this is what you can expect:

Welcome! There Will Be Smiling Faces to Greet You!

Our teachers and greeters will either be wearing masks or shields in the hallways or in the classroom when they are not the speaking teacher. So whether you can see our smile or not, it is there!

Health Check:

A greeter in the breezeway or just inside the KZ door will check the temperature of everyone entering the building.

Wearing Masks: Masks are encouraged in the Kid Zone but they are not required. Masks are helpful especially when entering, and when walking in the hallways.

Check-In and Exiting: One parent should handle check at the kiosk to acquire their child's security badge (1st-4th 9:00 and K-4th at 10:30). Preteens (5th and 6th graders) can check themselves in and they will not be required to wear a security badge. However, they should go straight to the Preteen classroom. After class or KZL parents, preteens and children should plan to exit out the back side door of the KZ building.

Classroom Connection: A parent should walk with their child to the classroom. At 10:20, our classroom teachers will walk kids who are staying for the 2nd hour to the KZL room and see that they have washed and sanitized their hands as they enter.

Social Distancing: Please follow the taped markings on the floor to make social distancing possible. Chairs will be set up in the classrooms and in KZL for social distancing.

Please partner with us for safety. Please do not come into the KZ building if:

- You have had a fever of 100.4 degrees or higher in the last 24 hours.
- You have any respiratory infections, frequent coughing/sneezing, shortness of breath, vomiting or diarrhea in the last 24 hours.
- Contact with someone with confirmed case of Covid-19, contact with someone quarantined due to exposure to Covid-19 in the last 10 days.
- You have traveled on a cruise or internationally in the last 14 days.

We are taking seriously the health and safety of children and preteens, and we feel good about the plans that are in place. However, we ask that you partner with us in understanding that with children of multiples ages no amount of preparation can guarantee *perfect* social distancing.
